The team did a great job of tying multiple concepts together while focusing primarily on the actions / email as a task list. While the AI based sorting is cool, there is a lot of opportunity to improve how the AI suggestion feature is presented. The swipe gestures are great but they leave out basic swipe actions like Archive and Delete.

Apart from Team 6, Team 5 did a good job of showing an AI system that works on top of the current UI layer. While the execution of the idea needs work, the way the solution was mapped to the problem / opportunity was easy to follow. Also, good
